Quick Takes at MPS

- Graduation rate: 100% last school year
- Proud achievement in state accountability: Significant improvement, above-state-average numbers in most grades and subject areas
- Tax levy rate: Almost 22 cents below the NE levy limit

- Special education services are provided to all students in need as well as higher learning opportunities.
- More than 37 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.

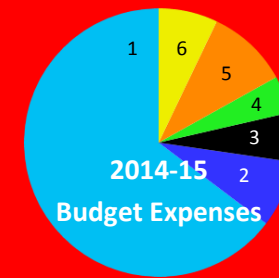


...Stories of growth

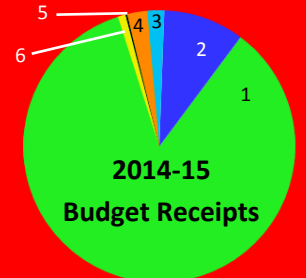
- Enrollment has increased at MPS by 6.3% since 2012-13.
- The smallest class in grades 1-6 is 12 students.
- The elementary preschool has 19 students that attend the program.
- The MPS band now has 24 students in grades 7-12 and 25 students in grades 5-6.
- Five more elective classes were offered to the schedule in 2015-16 in comparison to 2014-15.
- Maywood high school began an athletic cooperation in 2015-16 with Hayes Center to raise participation numbers for both districts.

...Stories in stewardship

- The 2015-16 budget for MPS is \$4,915,830.
- The General Fund property tax asking is .819544, and the Special Building Fund property tax asking is .014556 for a total tax asking of .834100.
- Out of the 15 RPAC Conference schools, MPS ranks sixth in lowest tax levies.
- The 2014-15 cost per pupil at MPS is \$19,692.56.

...Stories in accountability

- Maywood Public School's ACT composite score was a 17.1 in 2013 and a 17.8 in 2014. For the 2015 school year, the MPS composite score improved to 19.8.
- The 2015 state average composite score was a 21.5 so the staff is working hard to improve each child's education so they are better prepared for college and the work force.
- All high school students are offered the opportunity to take an online course for ACT test preparation on top of their quality daily education.
- Every student has their own individual educational plan set in place with goals and activities set to their educational ability in Reading, Math, and English.
