The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Haves, and Lincoln.
- Special education services are provided to all students in need as well as higher learning opportunities. Services are delivered in mainstreamed classrooms
- More than 50 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.
- All MPS students received free breakfast and lunch for 2020-2021 resulting from Coronavirus funding.



... Stories of growth

- Enrollment at MPS reflects zero growth.
- The elementary preschool has 22 students that attend the program.
- Students will improve writing skills in all subject areas. This goal drives school improvement efforts at MPS.
- Maywood High School is in the sixth year, of a ten year athletic cooperation, with Hayes Center The Wolves have done a great job of competing and growing as a team each year in the COOP.
- Lady Wolves Volleyball participated in the 2020 State Tournament finishing fourth!
- Despite on-line learning in March , student MAPS scores improved.



....Stories in stewardship

- The 2019-20 budget for MPS was \$6,326,378.
- The General Fund Property Tax Asking for 2019-20 was \$2,971,868, requiring 85.9533 cents tax.
- No Special Building Fund taxes.
- The 2019 –20 cost per pupil at MPS was \$24,815.
- State Aid (TEEOSA) \$130,214.
- Total State Aid from All Revenue Sources \$498,078.
