Quick Takes at MPS

- Graduation rate: 100% last school year
- Proud achievement in state accountability: Significant improvement, above-state-average numbers in most grades and subject areas
- Tax levy rate: Almost 23 cents below the NE levy limit

The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Hayes, and Lincoln.
- Special education services are provided to all students in need as well as higher learning opportunities.
- More than 37 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.



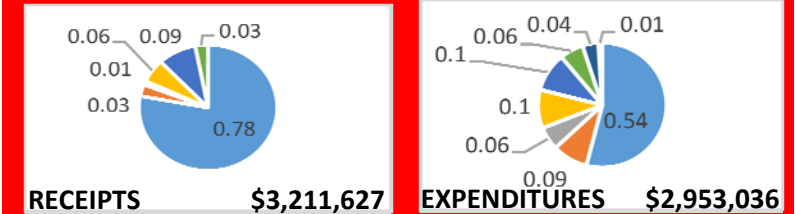
...Stories of growth

- Enrollment has increased at MPS by 6.3% since 2012-13.
- The elementary preschool has 16 students that attend the program.
- Students will improve writing skills in all subject areas. This goal drives school improvement efforts at MPS.
- Six more elective classes were offered to the schedule in 2016-2017 in comparison to 2015-2016.
- Maywood High School is in the second year, of a five year athletic cooperation, with Hayes Center High School in an effort to raise participation numbers for both districts.



...Stories in stewardship

- The 2015-16 budget for MPS was \$4,915,830.
- The General Fund property tax asking for 2015-16 was .819544, and the Special Building Fund property tax asking was .014556 for a total tax asking of .834100.
- The 2015-16 cost per pupil at MPS was \$19,692.56.

...Stories in accountability

- Maywood Public Schools' ACT composite score was a 19.8 in 2015 and a 17.8 in 2014. For the 2015-16 school year, the MPS composite score improved to 22.9
- The 2015-16 state average composite score was a 21.4, so the staff is working hard to improve each child's education so they are better prepared for college and the work force.
- All high school students are offered the opportunity to take an online course for ACT test preparation on top of their quality daily education.
- Every student has their own individual educational plan set in place with goals and activities set to their educational ability in Reading, Math, and English.
